**PROJECT SCOPE:**

This project is part of the County's Major Streets and Transportation Improvement Program (MSTIP), as approved by voters in 1995. The proposed improvements will involve constructing a 3-lane connection between Walker Road and Baseline Road utilizing the 170<sup>th</sup> Ave. / 173<sup>rd</sup> Ave. corridors. Improvements such as bike lanes, sidewalks, and a new structure for the Willow Creek tributary are anticipated, however, no specific details or alignments have been developed. We are holding this open house now to get your thoughts and ideas as we begin work on this project.

**GETTING INVOLVED WITH THE PROJECT:**

A Project Advisory Committee (PAC) will be formed to provide recommendations to the Project Management Team. The PAC will be made up of representatives from the neighborhood, property owners, public agency staff and public interest groups. If you are interested in participating on the PAC there are several ways to obtain an application, including attendance at this open house, visiting the project web site to download an application, or contacting one of the County staff listed below. As the project progresses, there will be additional open houses, project newsletters and updates to the web sites.

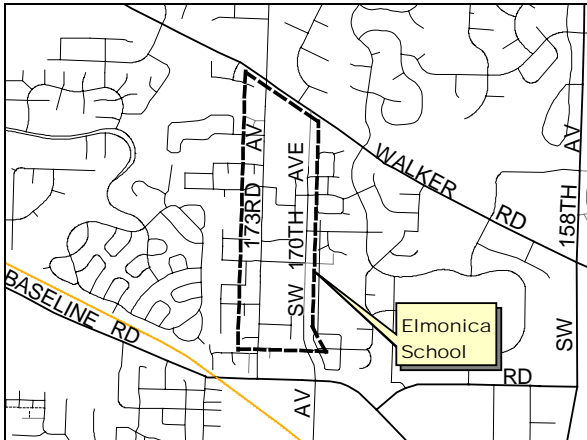
The County will also upon request endeavor to arrange for the following services to be provided:
