



### **Project Background**

The project will improve and widen NW Saltzman Road to three lanes (two travel lanes and a center turn lane) and include safety and intersection improvements, bike lanes and sidewalks. Other enhancements include improved road geometry, illumination, new water quality and storm drainage facilities, utility upgrades and new traffic signals at NW 128<sup>th</sup> Terrace and at NW Dogwood Street.

The NW Saltzman Road construction project is part of the on-going Major Streets and Transportation Improvement Program (MSTIP 3B/3C) and is funded through Washington County's general fund.

### **Construction Schedule**

A copy of the preliminary construction schedule is shown on the back of this handout. Construction activities will start within the next few weeks beginning with site preparation (clearing and grubbing operations) and utility upgrades and relocations. This work will be followed by installation of retaining walls and storm drainage facilities. After that will be the road construction (grading and widening, concrete flatwork and paving) and then final grading and landscaping. Project completion is anticipated to be November, 2010.

### **Construction Parameters and Impacts**

In order to try and minimize disruptions to residents, business owners and the traveling public during the construction activities, Washington County will:

- Minimize noise impacts, by limiting construction activity; construction generally will not be allowed on Sundays, holidays and between the hours of 7:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. Monday through Saturday. An exception to this will be the installation of a new 24" waterline. Because of necessary work in the Saltzman/Cornell intersection, this work will be performed at night.
- Maintain one travel lane in each direction on all streets within the project during non-work hours. The contractor will be permitted lane restrictions (close a lane of traffic with flagging) between the hours of 9:00 a.m.-3:30 p.m. during weekdays.
- Maintain access to businesses and residences at all times. There will be instances where accesses will need to be closed temporarily for construction purposes. At those times, an alternate access will be made available or the resident notified in advance.
- Maintain communication with the public as the construction proceeds. Periodic construction updates will be issued as well as updates posted in the Cedar Mills News, CPO newsletters, and on the project website. The goal will be to keep residents and business owners aware of upcoming construction activities, their locations and related impacts that may be encountered during the activities.
- With all construction activities, there will be noise, dust, vibrations, traffic congestion, and limited accesses. The County apologizes in advance for these inconveniences and appreciates your understanding and patience during the construction.
